Tim Plaisted lives in Zürich, Switzerland. Plaisted's work utilises a range of media including video, real-time 3D, software and installation, often to encourage subtle interactions with the viewer. His work has been exhibited in Australia, Germany, Mexico, Singapore, South Korea, UK, USA and reviewed in Artforum. Surface Browser was commissioned for the NESTA UK gallery and included in "2004: Australian Culture Now" national survey of contemporary art at the Australian Centre for Moving Image, Multimedia Arts Asia Pacific Festival in Singapore and reworked for the Choose Your Filter exhibition at the ZKM in Germany. He was the recipient of Australia Council grants for Loud and to produce New TV.
